

## Guidelines and conditions for granting free scholarships for undergraduate studies (Bachelor's degree):

1- Universities provide programs for non-Iraqi students on their official website, which indicate the conditions and regulations (below) for granting free scholarships for undergraduate studies only. Applications can be submitted through these websites starting from the date of March 15, 2023, for the academic year 2023-2024, or through the Missions Department/links to universities on the department's website.

2- The channels for scholarships for non-Iraqi students for undergraduate studies only are:

a. Scholarships according to programs, agreements, and protocols of cooperation with Arab and foreign countries. b. Scholarships provided by the Arab Universities Union. c. Scholarships for Arab and foreign residents in Iraq. d. Scholarships for Arab and foreign non-residents in Iraq.

3- Specializations are determined by the government universities, with a commitment to allocate a percentage not exceeding (5%) of the admission plan for each specialization for each of the above-mentioned scholarship channels.

4- A maximum percentage of (5%) of the admission plan for each specialization for each of the above-mentioned scholarship channels is designated by universities/colleges to provide scholarships for non-Iraqi students.

5- The age limit for scholarship applicants (for undergraduate studies) should not exceed 30 years old.

6- The minimum admission limits for scholarships are as follows:

a. medical group (General Medicine with a GPA of 85%, Dentistry and Pharmacy with a GPA of 75%). b. Engineering and Nursing

specializations with a GPA of 65%. c. Other scientific and humanitarian specializations with a GPA of 60%.

7- The student must submit his/her accredited documents, certified by the authorized authorities in his/her country and by the Iraqi embassy or consulate in that country. Government and private universities are responsible for verifying the authenticity of students' documents within a period not exceeding the first academic year.

8- The Missions and Cultural Relations Department facilitates the procedures for granting entry or residency permits in collaboration with the relevant ministries for scholarship students.

9- Universities have the right to impose additional conditions and regulations for accepting non-Iraqi students on scholarships.
